
The Life and lines of 1117



## The Wars of the Roses

This is a modern name for a period of civil war in England which lasted from 1455 until 1487. English military failure in France, an economic downturn and a lack of leadership from King Henry VI led to a violent struggle between factions of the English ruling class. These factions grouped round two branches of the Royal family who provided rival claimants to the throne: the House of Lancaster (King Henry's branch of the family) and the House of York (King Henry's cousins).
